




Sight Word Activities

Activities to help early learners recognize and use high frequency sight words

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Imtroduction

The sight word activities in this book derived from a combination of needs. I was teaching a composite class and needed easily prepared activities and my colleague, Toni Davis, required some new and interesting activities for her early learners, to help consolidate their learning of sight words.

The children are required to focus on two words per week usually as a homework task, with corresponding class activities involving two activity pages reinforcing the learning process. These activities can be effectively used in conjunction with other classroom activities to consolidate children's word knowledge, e.g. modelled writing, oral reading, story telling and so on.

The worksheets are designed for early learners as well as those requiring revision of skills. The minimal writing requirements are reinforced by being modelled and repeated on a page several times.


At the completion of each list of thirteen words a revision sheet is provided to further reinforce the children's learning and to evaluate their level of understanding ("Do you know your words?" pages 19 and 35). In addition a means of children recording their progress is provided in the "Words I know" sheets on pages 20 and 36.


